Summer Math Camps:

In person classes are held in Ellicott City. 6 Math Camp classes per grade level plus 3 Thinking Strategy/Math Game Camp sessions (9 total classes offered). Your payment of \$295 covers 6 classes and HW book. I scheduled three extra classes since students miss class due to vacations/camp schedules. Your child can attend any combination of Math Camp and Thinking Strategy/Math Game classes to equal 6 classes. Each class is 1 hour. Parents receive a summary email each week with what your child learned and photos from class! Your children will get a HW book with practice problems each week to help with retention of math skills during the summer! They will show me the completed HW each Math Camp class to hold them accountable!!

How to determine Math Level? For example, if your child was in First Grade this year and worked above grade level doing second grade math objectives, then your child will register for the 3rd grade group. Or, if your child is on grade level and just finished Grade 2 math, then you would sign up for the Grade 3 class.

Summer Math Camp (Wednesdays and Thursdays):

In person classes are held in Ellicott City. 6 Math Camp 1 hour classes per grade level plus 3 Thinking Strategy/Math Game Camp session (9 total classes offered). Your payment of \$295 covers 6 classes and HW book. I scheduled three extra classes since students miss class due to vacations/camp schedules. This year I spread out the make-up classes. Your child can attend any combination of Math Camp and Thinking Strategy/Math Game classes to equal 6 classes. Each class is **1 hour**. Parents receive a summary email each week with what your child learned and photos from class! Your children will get a HW book with practice problems each week to help with retention of math skills during the summer! They will show me the completed HW each Math Camp class to hold them accountable!!
